CMLL Game Day Procedures

1 Hour Prior to the Game

Team Warm Ups

- Stretching
- Hitting
 - All hitting into nets needs to be done outside of the outfield fence and not on the outfield or infield grass. Dirt in foul ground can be used.
 - All hitting needs to be completed 20 minutes before the start of the game.
- Throwing

Home Team

- Remove pitching mound and home plate covers. Place them near a storage container. (first game of the day)
- Drag the infield dirt (*if not done by the prior game visiting team*)
- Water the infield dirt and batters box. Pitching mound gets a light spritz.
- Stripe the foul lines, batters box, and halfway marks between bases (*Minor C only*).
- Setup the bases (first game of the day)
- Brings out 3 new baseballs
- Brings out the scorebook (Minor C & Above)
 - Home Team is responsible for keeping score.
 - Minor C Scorekeeper keeps the pitch count and runs scored.
- Setup the American Flag (If in storage container)

20 Minutes Prior to the Game

Place bats, batting helmets, and catcher's helmet along the outside dugout fence. (*Minor C & Above*)

Umpire(s) arrive to field. (Minor C & Above)

15 Minutes Prior to the Game

Umpire(s) inspects playing equipment: bats, batting helmets, catcher's gear and helmet. (*Minor C & Above*)

Starting pitcher starts warming up with catcher. (*Minor C & Above*)

10 Minutes Prior to the Game

End warmups and head to the dugout.

Give lineup to the scorekeeper.

5 Minutes Prior to the Game

All players in the dugout and ready to play.

Provide pitching affidavit to the scorekeeper. (Affidavit Template)

Pre-Game Plate Conference with Managers & Umpire(s) {Rule 4.01} (Minor C & Above)

- The umpires shall proceed directly to home plate where they shall be met by the managers of the opposing teams, just preceding the established time to begin the game.
- Exchange names with each other.
- Managers will:
 - Exchange batting orders with the opposing team.
 - Share which pitchers are ineligible to pich to due to pitch count regelation.
 - Discuss playing field ground rules.

3 Minutes Prior to the Game

Line up on the 1st base & 3rd base foul lines for the Pledge of Allegiance & Little League Pledge (littleleague.org/who-we-are/pledge/).

After the Game

Post Game Team Meeting (in outfield)

- Player of the Game
- Can use one of the game balls

Clean up the dugout

Managers (*Minor C & Above*)

- Retrieve pitching affidavit from the scorekeep and bring it to the opposing manager to verify and sign.
- Keep affidavit with you and bring to all games.

Home Team

- Put away the score book
- Enter scores into Sports Connect (*Minor B & Above*)

Visitor Team

- Drag the infield
- Last Day of the Game
 - o Water the infield dirt and batters box. Pitching mound gets a light spritz.
 - Put away bases
 - o Put the pitching mound cover on. Do not let it touch the grass or it will die.
 - o Put the home plate cover on. Do not let it touch the grass or it will die.
 - Put away American flag
 - Lock up storage container
 - Lock up the field
